A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.: 717-24 TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE REQUESTED GRANT IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$16,000,000.00, REMOVING THE 20% GRANT MATCH BY THE CITY AND COMMITTING \$3,000,000.00 IN CITY FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Birmingham, Alabama, that Resolution No. 717-24, adopted by the Council on May 14, 2024, under which the Council of the City of Birmingham, Alabama authorized the Mayor to take any and all actions and to execute such documents as are appropriate and necessary to apply for, submit, execute, expend, accept, and to take any and all actions as are appropriate and necessary in accordance with the terms of the Grant submission requirements and Grant Agreement with the US Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP) Grant, be and hereby is amended to authorize the Mayor to take any and all actions and to execute such documents as are appropriate and necessary to apply for, submit, execute, expend, accept, and to take any and all actions as are appropriate and necessary in accordance with the terms of the Grant submission requirements and Grant Agreement with the US Department of Transportation. Federal Highway Administration Active Transportation Infrastructure Investment Program (ATIIP) Grant for the purpose of to providing complete street amenities such as bike lanes, sidewalks, side paths, and traffic calming along 56 road segments across the City to fill in missing gaps in the City's street network as well as resurfacing streets in

need as part of the project in an amount up to \$16,000,000.00 with no matching funds due from the city and committing \$3,000,000.00 in City funding for the project.
